

Closing the Vista Onscreen Keyboard Using Interwrite Boards, Pads or Panels

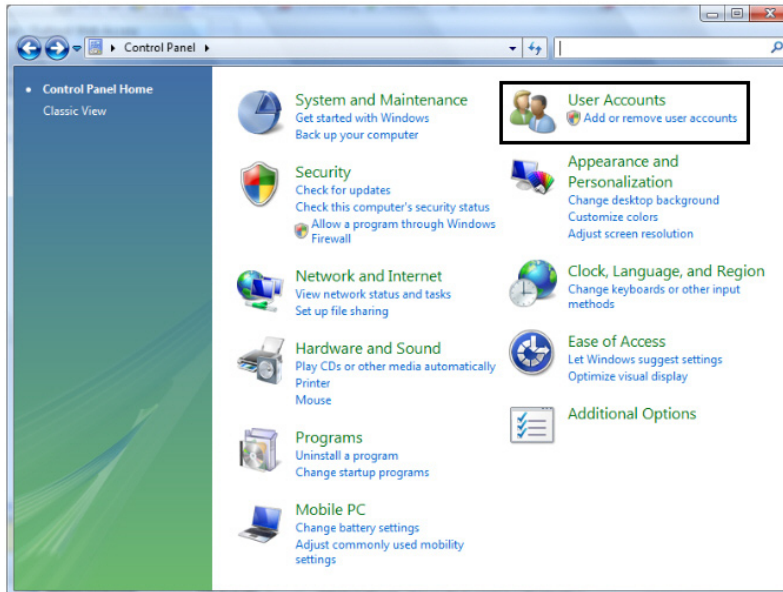


This issue applies with Microsoft Vista only.

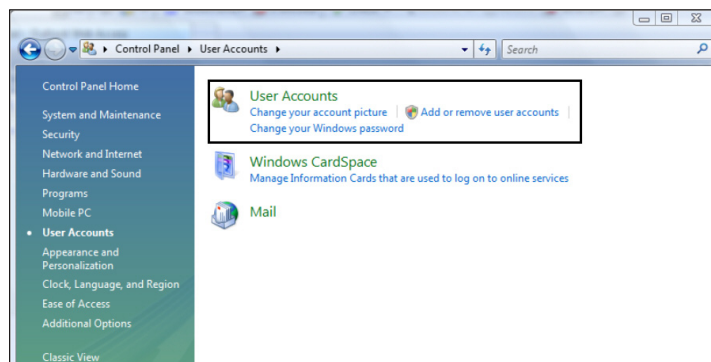
Once the Onscreen Keyboard is opened, it cannot be closed using the Interwrite Board, Pad, or Panel. It must be closed using the mouse. This issue can be avoided by turning off the User Account Control feature in Microsoft Vista.

Turning Off the User Accounts Control in Vista

- 1 Go to **Start Menu>Control Panel**.
The *Control Panel* window opens.



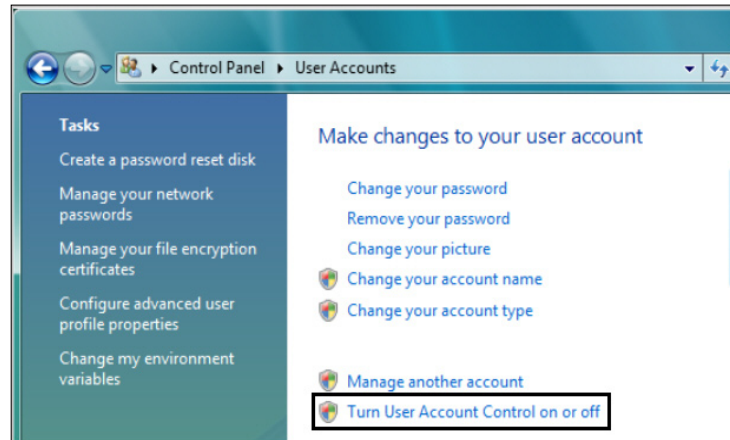
- 2 Select **User Accounts**.
The *User Accounts* window opens.





3 Select **User Accounts**.

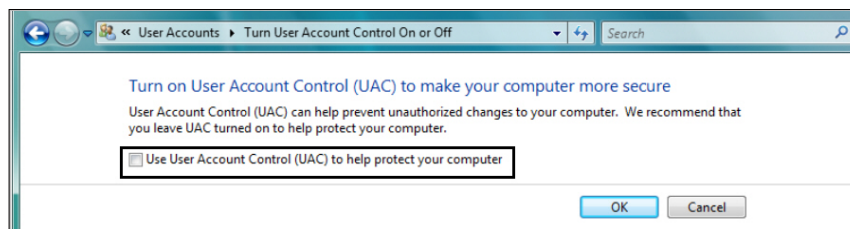
The *Make Changes to your User Account* window opens.



4 Select **Turn User Account Control on or off**.

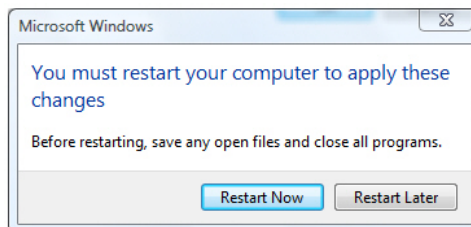
The *Turn on User Account Control (UAC) to make your computer more secure* window opens.

5 Deselect the **Use User Account (UAC) to help protect your computer** checkbox.



6 Click **OK**.

The *You must restart your computer to apply these changes* dialog box opens.



7 Click **Restart Now**.

The machine reboots and the changes are saved.
